## RESIDENT SPONSORED CHELSEA GUEST POINTS

MOST CLUBS WITHIN THE CHELSEA INFORMATION SYSTEMS FAMILY ASSIGN GUEST POINTS. THIS HAS BEEN AN ISSUE OF DISCUSSION FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS AND NOW WITH THE SIZE OF OUR COMMUNITY AND MEMBERSHIP INCREASING YEARLY, WE HAVE NOW REACHED THAT POINT IN TIME FOR ENHANCED YEAR ROUND SEASONAL MAINTENANCE.

Effective July 20<sup>th</sup>, play points for guest play was invoked in the Chelsea reservation system. Any resident sponsoring a guest or multiple guests will be assessed play points to include the Placement and End of Day play points. Points assessed are predicated on member type. Annual members .1 point per guest; Play Card 80 (Gold) is .25 points per guest; Play Card 40 (Silver) is .75 points per guest; Non-Member is 1 point for placement and 2 points for End of Day for each guest.

The daily placement and EOD points are assessed at EOD, at approximately 3:30 a.m. Eastern the day following placement or play. The Chelsea point total always lags one day behind what appears on the Review Points report.

The flag for yes was set to "Yes" on July 20<sup>th</sup> for the assessment of points and captured all guests in the current 14 day member play history (cycle) and assessed guest placement points and EOD points. This was unavoidable.

Chelsea Programming has been requested to invoke "in Season Guest" rules. Our season is set to the calendar year. We have requested that requests in the placement process to be based on the team's composition by member type in four separate rounds:

Round 1- Annual (00) and/or Non-Annual (01), Play Card 40 (03), Play Card 80 (04) with NO guests

Round 2- Annual (00) and/or Non-Annual (01), Play Card 40 (03), Play Card 80 (04) with ONE guest

Round 3- Annual (00) and/or Non-Annual (01), Play Card 40 (03), Play Card 80 (04) with TWO guests

Round 4- Annual (00) and/or Non-Annual (01), Play Card 40 (03), Play Card 80 (04) with THREE guests

The above member types are the only member types programmed to initiate requests in the reservation system. Member types, 02 (Non-Resident) and 90 (Reciprocal) are not valid member types with access to Chelsea and not included in the placement process. Chelsea programming indicates that the above rules (1 through 4) will engage either EOD July 21st or July 22nd.
